**The Big Bear Amateur Radio Club meets on Saturday mornings in two separate nets. The first starts at 08:00 hours on the 75 meter band on 3935 Khz plus or minus QRM. The second session starts at 09:00 hours simulcast on the K6BB repeaters on
147.330 Mhz up 600 with a PL of 131.8 and on 446.200 Mhz down 5 Mhz with a PL of 103.5. These repeaters are solely owned, operated, and maintained by the Big Bear Amateur Radio Club. All donations are gratefully accepted and appreciated....**
